

Eco Dyeing Workshop for Beginners with Birgit Moffatt

Description

Eco Dyeing (also called leaf print or eco print) is a direct contact dye method drawing out pigments from leaves into fabric. In this workshop you will learn about how to successfully eco dye on protein fibres (silk). We will go for a short walk around the hub to collect some plant material, which we will then use to create our silk bundles. Let's get wild!

You will learn

- about plants and fabrics
- equipment
- mordant techniques
- 2 different bundle techniques

Included in the workshop fee are 2 scarf size pieces of silk and a handout with mordant recipes, dye plants, tips, sources etc.

Tools and materials for the workshop are provided; a 'what to bring list' will be sent out closer to the workshop.
