Harakeke is an ideal fibre for this project and you will learn how to use it 'from scratch' including tikanga (protocol) for harvesting and working with harakeke.

After this workshop you will be able to start experimenting with other fibres and forms.

- harvest, storage and preparation of natural fibres
- other fibres that are suitable for random weaving
- manipulation and finishing of your pod/nest
